### Beach clean-up tools

- ✓ Utilise the tools in the “Clean Pod” sponsored by SCIC if you heading to [Area C4](#) of East Coast Park



#### In the Clean Pod:

- 2 Carts
- Sieves to collect plastic
- 30 plastic pails
- Around 100 metal tongs
- Weighing scales

Note: Password to access the clean pod will be provide upon your application approval

- ✓ Remember to hydrate yourself,
- ✓ Bring along your cap and sunglasses
- ✓ Wear proper footwear. Be SAFE!

### Beach clean-up Activity

- ✓ Use separate trash bags to collect plastic and non-plastic waste



- ✓ Weigh the plastic and non-plastic waste collected and record the respective amounts
